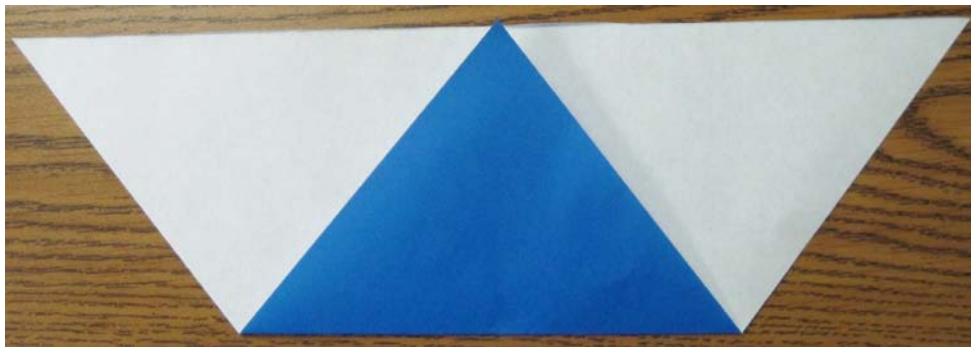


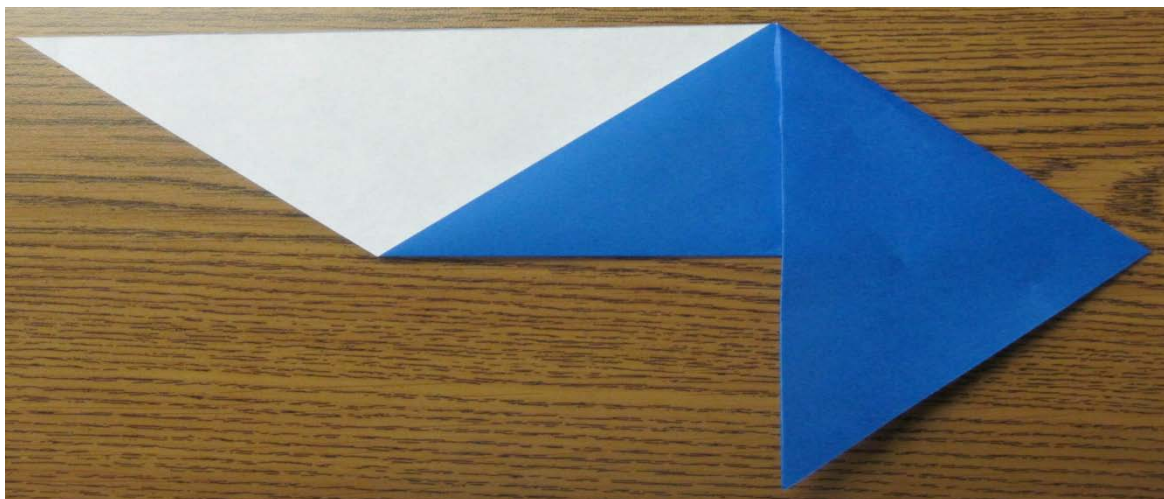
## Making an Origami Sailboat

We would like to receive a sailboat to represent each family that the CCC helps “stay afloat” with our services. The directions for folding an origami sailboat will be available on our website and in our office. In addition to wanting teachers & parents to provide us with sailboats, we would like to have children provide us with sailboats. There is no need to purchase special origami paper, you can use regular paper with one side decorated. Let your kids paint or color one side of the paper and then fold it into an origami sailboat.

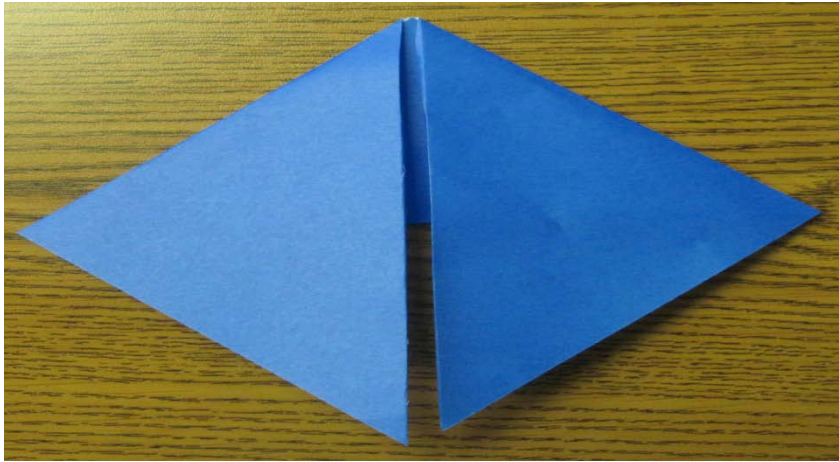

Lay the paper with the cut edge at the top. Fold the bottom point up until the point is resting on the line that was cut.

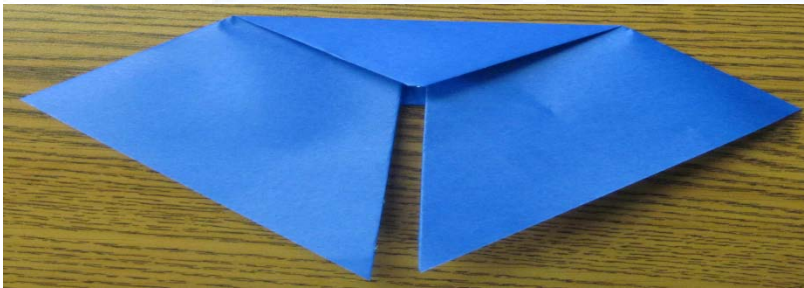


Now you will take the right side and fold it down at the point of the bottom half you had already folded up.

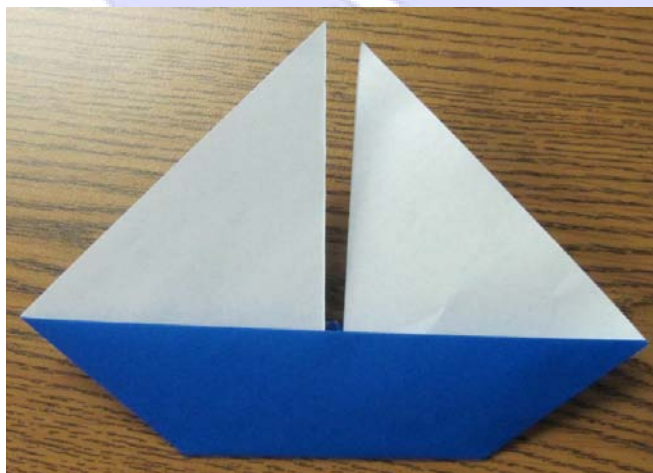


Repeat that fold with the left side of the paper. The back of your paper will now look like a diamond.

Now you will fold the top point down so that the point is level with the first fold that you can just see through the cracks of you folds.



Flip the paper over. Congratulations you have just completed an Origami Sailboat. Thank you for helping the Child Care Council of Kentucky keep families “afloat”!
